

DI-fining Your Role

One thing that appraisers look for, especially when giving out teamwork points, is clearly defined roles among the team members. Each role in IC makes it easier for the team to complete the task quickly and effectively. Here are some opportunities for your team to define their roles!

Timekeeper/Rules Interpretation/Appraiser Communicator: This role is one of the most crucial. This person must SCRUTINIZE the challenge, making sure that everything the team does will not get them or their solution disqualified. They carry a silent stopwatch and call out time signals every thirty seconds and the last 10 seconds as well. As soon as time starts, they start their stopwatch, remind the team of what the task is and any important reminders, AND remind the team where the points are. They also initiate 5 seconds of brainstorming before any solution is discussed. This person is also responsible for asking any questions to the appraisers.

Materials Manager: The materials manager is responsible for knowing what materials are available, reminding the builders of the creative ways they may use them (in a positive manner), knowing what the materials must do, and what the materials CANNOT DO according to the challenge.

Line Master: Anytime there is a line that cannot be crossed in the IC, the line master is responsible for knowing where that line is and helping those trying to complete the task by guiding them with positive reminders of where the line is. The Line Master is also responsible for ENSURING that if you get a performance IC that the team remembers to have a CLEAR beginning, middle, and END!

Limit Master: The limit master has a very difficult job. They must decide when a tower has reached its maximum height, a bridge has spanned the maximum distance, or any time a device has been built and has reached its limit. They must prevent the device from failing without stopping the team too early and preventing them from reaching the maximum points possible.

Teamwork Monitor: The Teamwork Monitor is responsible for making sure that the appraisers hear consistent GENUINE positive encouragement from the team. They must assist in any way needed and must constantly be the "Cheerleader" of the team. This person will always carry at least 20 points on their shoulders.

Building Masters: The building masters are responsible for knowing EVERY WAY in which a material may be used and HOW CREATIVELY it can be used and still work well! These team members are responsible for the actual creation of the device and operation of it. They must make it work!
